**STIPULATION AND ORDER ALLOWING PAYMENTS TO PREVAILING  
CLASS MEMBERS TO BE MADE THROUGH POORMAN-DOUGLAS CORPORATION**

This matter having come before the Court at the parties' joint request, it is hereby:


1. ORDERED that cash payments to class members prevailing on credit claims pursuant to ¶ 9(a)(iii)(B) and ¶ 10(g)(i) of the Consent Decree,<sup>2</sup> exclusive of any amount paid by the

<sup>2</sup> Pursuant to ¶ 9(b)(iii)(A), any payments to class members prevailing on non-credit claims are made by the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

Judgment Fund directly to the Internal Revenue Service pursuant to ¶ 9(a)(iii)(C), shall be made as follows:

- a. The Judgment Fund shall transfer the prevailing class member's payment, exclusive of any amount paid by the Judgment Fund directly to the Internal Revenue Service pursuant to ¶ 9(a)(iii)(C), electronically to the Poorman-Douglas Corporation.
- b. Upon receipt of the electronic payment described in ¶ 1(a), above, the Poorman-Douglas Corporation shall issue a check to the class member for the full amount of such payment. And it is further

2. ORDERED that the Poorman-Douglas Corporation shall provide to the parties on a monthly basis records of the payments received from the Judgment Fund and the checks issued to prevailing class members pursuant to ¶ 1, above.
